Town of Saxeville
Waushara County, Wisconsin

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING IN DESIGNATED
AREAS OF THE TOWN OF SAXEVILLE, WISCONSIN**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Saxeville, Waushara County, Wisconsin, has the authority to regulate parking on town roads within the Town of Saxeville;

WHEREAS, the Town Board believes it is in the best interest of public health, safety and general welfare to prohibit parking within designated areas of the Town of Saxeville;

WHAREAS, the Waushara County Sheriff's Department has agreed to enforce the "no parking area" ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Saxeville does ordain as follows:

SECTION I – POSTED LIMITATIONS

No operator of a vehicle shall park in any area designated as a "no parking" area by a traffic officer or traffic control signal or sign.

SECTION II – PARKING RESTRICTIONS DURING WEATHER EMERGENCY

Whenever the Town Chair shall, by reason of heavy snowstorm or other weather event, proclaim a snow or weather emergency pursuant to Wis. Stat. sec. 323.11, no person shall park, stop or leave standing any vehicle upon the streets or any portion of the streets during the hours set forth in such proclamation.

SECTION III – IMPEDING PARKING ON TOWN ROADS

No person may impersonate a traffic officer, or otherwise impede parking on town roads for any reason. This section does not apply to emergency vehicles.

SECTION IV – VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

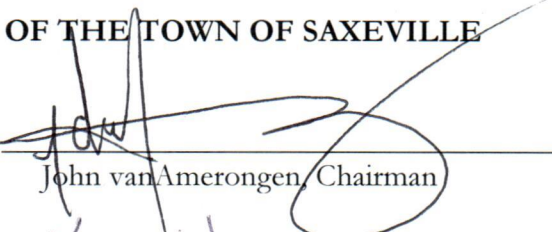
Violations of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a forfeiture of \$100.00 for each instance of noncompliance together with court costs and the costs of prosecution.

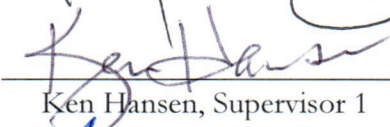
SECTION V – EFFECTIVE DATE

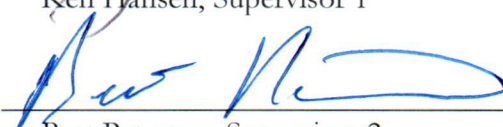
This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as provided by law.

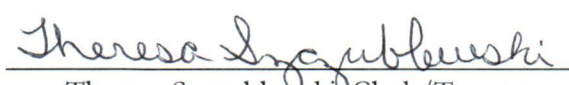
