#### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION 7.00 – 7.15 P.M.**

#### Residents attended to raise the following issues:-

Why have the posts for the ex notice board been left – Maple Way. The chairman explained that for the moment they have been left in the event of an additional notice board being introduced at a later date. A resident informed the council that dog fouling was an issue within Branston parish and not to target the playing field, Clays Lane. A resident felt that the parish council could promote a campaign to stop dog fouling in the parish.

A resident asked why the parish council were not allowing any further legitimate questions about the pavilion. The chairman informed the resident that further questions could be raised via St Modwens developers. A resident raised concerns regarding litter and grass cutting – Clays Lane playing field. A resident informed the council that residents wanted a skate park/Muga on Clays Lane. A resident wanted to know when the website was going to be up and running for St Modwens. A resident asked if she could have the email addresses for all parish councillors as emails were only going to the clerk/chairman and not circulated to all parish councillors.
