



BRANSTON PARISH COUNCIL HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

The parish council recognizes its duty of care to ensure, as far as practicable, the health, safety and welfare of its employees, members, contractors and those who use its amenities.

In particular the council will:

- Comply with relevant legal and statutory requirements
- Provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from its activities and amenities
- Consult with employees in matters affecting their health and safety
- Undertake annual H&S reviews of all Council facilities/amenities/operations and put in place any remedial action necessary
- Provide and maintain safe equipment
- Ensure safe handling and use of substances
- Ensure all employees and members are competent for their tasks
- Maintain safe and healthy working conditions
- Ensure that any contractor working for the council is H&S competent and compliant
- Review this policy annually and revise as necessary
