

NOTICE OF PROJECT PLANNING PUBLIC MEETING

The Village of Mesick will hold a public meeting on the proposed Water System Improvements Project for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

The meeting will be held at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 10th, 2023 at Mesick's Village Hall.

The purpose of the proposed project is improvements to the Village's water distribution system.

Project construction will involve improvements to the water system. Changes to the water system will include replacement of 4,830 linear feet of watermain, water storage tank improvements and painting, and relocation of a poorly placed water hydrant.

Impacts of the proposed project include minor traffic operation, increased local noise and dusts levels typically of a construction project. There are no anticipated long-term impacts from this project.

The estimated project costs are totaled to be approximately \$3.51 million. User rates will be adjusted to service the debt and operate and maintain the proposed improvements over time. The estimated cost increase to users for the proposed project will be discussed at the public meeting and the final costs will be dependent on the terms of the financing proposed by EGLE for this project.
