BIGELOW ASKED WHY THERE WAS NOT PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING SEWER PROJECT? HOW MANY CURRENT SEWER HOOK-UPS ARE THERE? HOW MANY RESIDENTS/BUSINESSES SHOULD HAVE HOOKED UP AND DID NOT?

HOWELL STATED THEY WOULD CONSIDER A PUBLIC MEETING. MCLEOD INFORMED HIM THAT CURRENTLY 105 SEWER CUSTOMERS ARE CONNECTED AND 8 THAT ARE CHARGED FOR SEWER BUT ARE NOT CONNECTED.

HUBER STATED HE HAD PROBLEMS WITH THE AMOUNT OF REU'S HE HAS BEEN ASSESSED IN 1998 AND WANTED TO KNOW HOW HE COULD RECTIFY THE AMOUNT HE HAS OVER PAID?

HOWELL STATED HE SHOULD HVE BROUGHT THIS UP WHEN THE SITUATION OCCURRED. SO MUCH TIME HAS ELAPSED THAT IT WILL BE DIFFICULT TO REPAY ANY AMOUNT IN ERROR.

HUBER ASKED IF THERE WAS A MISTAKE WOULD THE VILLAGE COMPENSATE. HOWELL SAID THEY WOULD LOOK INTO IT. HUBER ASKED HOW WE CAN CORRECT THIS?

HOWELL TOLD HIM THE VILLAGE WOULD START WITH THEIR ATTORNEY.

LAURIE BAILEY ASKED ABOUT THE CIVIL INFRACTION TICKETS THAT WERE TALKED ABOUT LAST FALL.

HOWELL STATED THAT THE VILLAGE HAS A TICKET BOOK AND AN OFFICER IN MIND. NEGOTIATIONS ARE CONTINUING WITH A OFFICER.
