MOTION BY STRANG SUPPORTED BY ABEL TO ACCEPT THE BILLS AS READ. ALL IN FAVOR;

HEYMES SUBMITTED BIDS FOR THE REPAIR OF THE WORK TRUCK. MOTION BY STRANG SUPPORTED BY SMITH TO ACCEPT THE BID FROM TOTAL TIRE OF \$8856.04 WITH A CAP OF \$11,000.00, ALL IN FAVOR: MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION BY SMITH SUPPORTED BY STRANG TO ACCEPT A BID FROM RAY'S WELDING OF \$27,200.00 FOR REPAIRS EARMARKED BY DEQ TO THE WATER DEPARTMENT, THE REPAIRS WILL BE PAID OUT OF THE RRI WATER ACCOUNT. ALL IN FAVOR; MOTION CARRIED.
