PLEDGE OF ALLIEGENCE

PRESIDENT CLOUS OPENED THE MEETING AT 7:00 P.M.

MOTION BY STRANG SUPPORTED BY ABEL TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS AMENDED CHANGING THE INSURANCE CLAIM IS NOT BEING CONTRACTED TO ELMERS BUT TO A GENERAL CONTRACTOR THAT THEY USE GLEN HAEFELE, AND THE BIBLE BELIEVERS REQUEST A PRIVATE SEPTIC SYSTEM. ALL IN FAVOR; MOTION CARRIED.
