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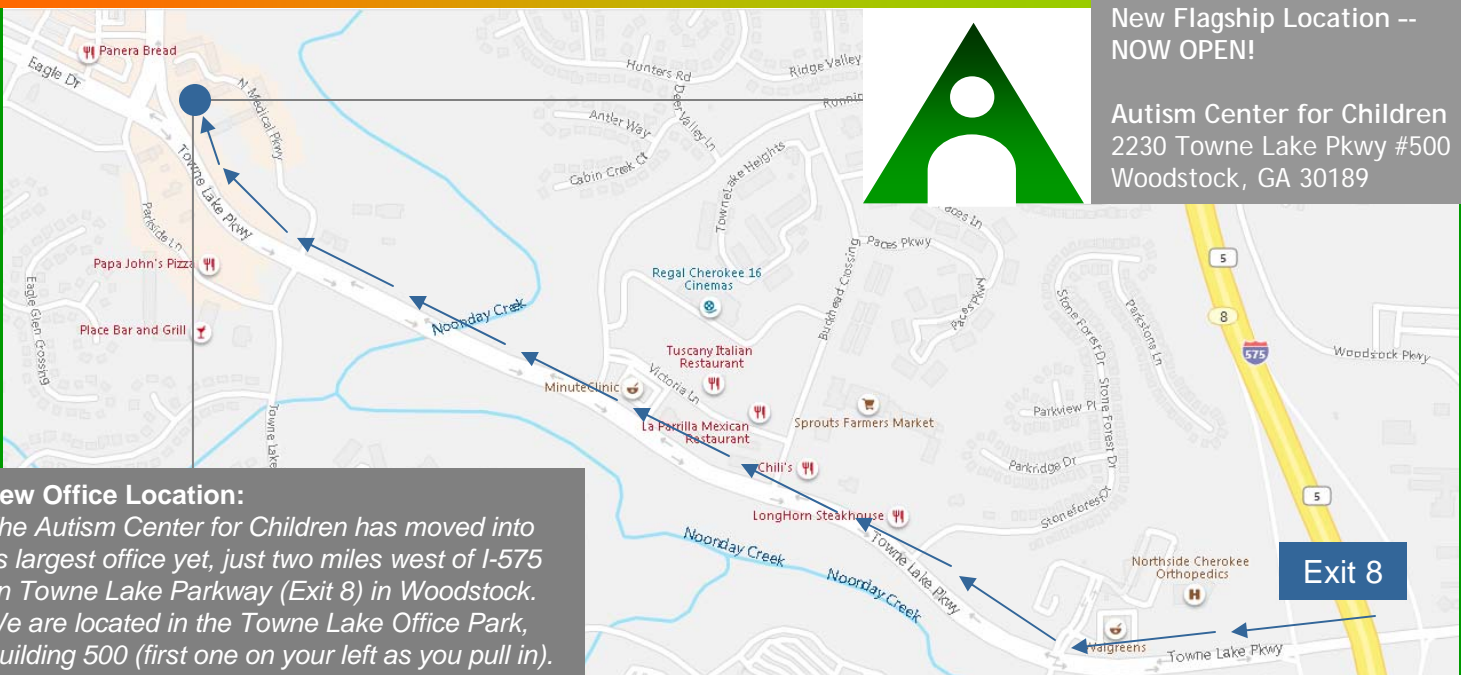

Our specialized services are available to families of:

- Children under 24 months for autism assessment
- Children under 24 months for intake for treatment after an autism diagnosis, featuring our intensive ABA treatment (lasting up to age 5 or prior graduation or transition)
- Best opportunities for entrance into the Autism Center for Children are at either the 12- or 18-month well child check

How to Refer to the Autism Center for Children:

- Send copy of insurance card (front and back)
- Send autism screening measure (ie M-CHAT) if available
- Refer clients for initial consult or a full assessment
- Full assessment takes 2-4 hours – following the evaluation, you will receive immediate, same-day feedback regarding the diagnostic impression
- Full report and care coordination will be delivered well within two weeks

Post-Diagnosis Treatment Steps:

- Check with us first to see if we have treatment availability
- If our waitlist is too long, we or your insurance providers can recommend other sources of ABA
