



**THE NEW
ERASMUS +
PROGRAMME**



In this document, you can find information related to the new Erasmus + Programme. New Guideline (document with all rules and funding possibilities) is not still published nevertheless you can get ready especially if your organization has not participated in the Programme yet. If you have any questions feel free to schedule Free Online Talk.

1 step

If your organization is a newcomer your first step is to register in order to receive your:

Organization ID number (OID) and PIC number.

Why does my organization need to register?

Without registration, your organization cannot apply for a project and also you cannot become a partner in the project consortium.

Why register for both - PIC and OID?

Because Erasmus + Programme is managed by National Agencies in participating countries and by the Education, Audiovisual, and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA), website: www.eacea.ec.europa.eu. For projects managed by the National Agencies.

Your organization needs OID and for projects managed by EACEA your organization needs PIC. The registrations are not complicated and you can find instruction on the following links:

PIC and **Organization ID**.

Question: I think we made registration of the organization and have PIC. Do we have OID?

In this case, you should receive OID automatically, check this [page](#), And search for your organization.



2 step

3 step (if needed)

Erasmus Accreditation

It is a new thing in the new Programme. The organizations can apply to be accredited for KA 1. Once they will be accredited they will not need to apply for each call. It means that you will not need to submit a full application for each project but your organization will submit a request for funding based on information provided in the accreditation. If you would like to know about Erasmus Accreditation more. Please, check information from your National Agency.

Why?

In the Czech Republic, National Agency informed us that Accreditation is for organizations that were applying for 10 or more projects. It means for organizations working with Erasmus + actively. In case that your organization applies 2-3 projects per year, they said to us that Accreditation is not needed.

On another side, I talked with my partners e.g. from Greece and they told me that every organization needs to get accredited.

Thus I would recommend you to check it out directly with your National Agency. The call for accreditation will be open each year.

4 step

Build a network of partners As the new call for proposals are being expected in early spring, you can now focus on developing a network of your partners.
