Day 1

Private Picnic at Milton Waterfall (11:30 AM – 1:30 PM)

You'll arrive at **Milton Waterfall**, where a **private picnic experience** will already be fully set up beneath the cascading falls. Our team will have secured the site exclusively from **11:00 AM to 2:00 PM**, ensuring complete privacy.

A separate vehicle will transport your chef and stewardess ahead of time, along with additional crew, to assist with final preparations. We will supply the **table, chairs, gazebo, and floral arrangement**, creating an elegant yet natural riverside setting. You'll have time to enjoy lunch, relax, explore the riverbanks, and—if you wish—take a refreshing swim in the pool beneath the falls, surrounded only by rainforest and birdsong.



Indian River Experience (2:15 PM – approx. 4:00 PM)

After the picnic, guests will be transferred by luxury vehicle to the Indian River landing. The rowboat tour proceeds upriver using oars only. As you glide upriver beneath towering swamp bloodwood trees, you'll experience one of Dominica's most atmospheric landscapes—quiet, shaded, and rich with birdlife. The tour includes a stop at the iconic **Bush Bar** and surrounding riverine botanical gardens, made famous by *Pirates of the Caribbean*.

At the conclusion, our Officer will guide the yacht's tender into the river mouth to collect guests.



Day 2

Morning Dives (9:00 AM – 12:30 PM)

This morning is dedicated to **two guided dives** in Dominica's **Northern Marine Reserve**, specifically **Douglas Bay** and **Toucari Bay**—areas known for excellent visibility, dramatic volcanic formations, and healthy reef systems.

Expect coral gardens, sponges, turtles, reef fish, and occasional pelagic sightings. Dive operations are relaxed and professional, suitable for experienced recreational divers



Lunch Onboard (Early Afternoon)

Following the dives, you'll enjoy a relaxed **lunch onboard**, with time to rest, refresh, and enjoy the views of Prince Rupert's Bay.

Cabrits National Park Historical Walking Tour (3:00 PM)

In the afternoon, we'll take you ashore for a guided walking tour of **Cabrits National Park**, home to the beautifully restored **Fort Shirley**.

Set on a peninsula overlooking Prince Rupert's Bay, the fort offers sweeping ocean views and a fascinating look into Dominica's colonial and naval history. You'll explore old barracks, gun batteries, and lookout points while learning how this strategic stronghold once protected the island.

The walk is gentle and scenic, with plenty of shaded paths and photo opportunities.



Clearance Notes

- Document collection and official clearances will take place upon the yacht's arrival in Dominica.
- We will complete landing cards on behalf of all guests.
- Guests will be required to review and sign landing cards prior to departure ashore.
- Signed documents will be submitted to Immigration by our team.

Concierge Notes & Considerations

- **Privacy & Security:**
Waterfall picnic site fully locked off during your visit. All logistics handled discreetly.
- **Crew Coordination:**
Separate transport arranged for culinary and service crew to support picnic setup and breakdown.
- **River Operations:**
Indian River is strictly oar-powered beyond the mouth, preserving the quiet and atmosphere.
- **Diving:**
Final dive sites subject to weather and sea conditions on the day.

- Light, breathable clothing
- Water shoes or sandals with grip (waterfall & river)
- Swimwear & quick-dry towel
- Sun hat & insect repellent

Day 2:

- Dive gear as required
- Comfortable walking shoes for Cabrits
- Light cover-up or linen for afternoon tour
