Notice Period For Slip & Falls Now Only 60 Days this should never happen to you but if it does!

Here we are in February, the very heart of Winter and the Government of Ontario has passed into law recent amendments to the Occupier's Liability Act which reduces the time for you to make a claim for a slip and fall accident from 2 years to 60 days! This, I can only guess, the Government thought was more in line with the 10-day period for claims, which is standard for injuries occurring on city-owned property under the Municipal Act.

It seems that Condominium Corporations and Snow Plowing Companies have much to gain from this change to the claims' period. Please pardon the pun, but again these gains by the Corporate World come on the backside of the general public.
