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Day 1 – Addis Ababa • Semera • Lake Afdera • Hamed Ela

Morning

Your adventure begins with a morning flight from Addis Ababa to Semera. Upon arrival, you will be welcomed by our professional guide and driver before departing in a fully equipped 4×4 Land Cruiser.

Following a short tour briefing, begin the scenic drive across the Afar Region toward the Danakil Depression.

En Route

Travel through dramatic volcanic landscapes, ancient lava fields, desert plains, and traditional Afar villages while learning about the region's unique geology and culture.

Stop at the beautiful **Lake Afdera**, a natural salt lake known for its warm mineral-rich waters.

Enjoy:

- Lunch overlooking the lake
- Optional swimming
- Photography opportunities
- Rest break before continuing into the desert

Afternoon

Continue toward Hamed Ela, the traditional gateway to the Danakil Depression.

Before sunset visit:

- Lake Asale
- Traditional salt mining sites
- Endless white salt flats
- Camel caravans transporting hand-cut salt blocks

Watch the spectacular sunset across one of the most surreal landscapes on Earth.

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Day 2 – Dallol • Salt Canyon • Camel Caravans • Erta Ale Volcano

Early Morning

After breakfast, depart for the famous Dallol geothermal field.

Explore one of Earth's most fascinating geological wonders featuring:

- Bright yellow sulfur deposits
- Green acid pools
- Orange mineral terraces
- Salt crystal formations
- Hydrothermal springs
- Volcanic landscapes unlike anywhere else

- Camel caravans crossing the salt plains

Arrive at Semera Airport for your afternoon flight to Addis Ababa.

Health & Environmental Safety

The Danakil Depression is one of the hottest places on Earth, with temperatures frequently exceeding **40°C (104°F)**.

To minimize heat-related risks:

- Drinking water is provided throughout the journey.
- Frequent hydration and rest breaks are scheduled.
- Activities are planned during cooler parts of the day whenever practical.
- Guests are encouraged to wear sun-protective clothing, hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen.
- Participants should inform the tour leader of any medical conditions or dietary requirements before departure.

Emergency Preparedness

Our vehicles carry:

- Comprehensive first-aid kits
- Emergency communication equipment where available
- Spare tires and essential recovery equipment
- Extra drinking water

In the event of severe weather, volcanic activity, road closures, or other unforeseen circumstances, the itinerary may be adjusted to prioritize guest safety.

Personal Security

Guests are advised to:

- Follow all instructions from guides and local authorities.
- Stay with the group at all times.
- Avoid approaching geothermal pools, unstable ground, or volcanic vents without permission.
- Keep passports, cash, and valuables secure.
- Respect local customs and traditions.
- Ask permission before photographing local residents.

Booking & Payment Policy

Reservation

Advance booking is strongly recommended due to limited group sizes.

Reservations are confirmed only after receipt of the required deposit.

Deposit

A **30% deposit** is required to secure your booking.

The remaining balance must be paid before the tour departure, according to the booking confirmation.

- Drink plenty of water throughout the day.

- Carry a fully charged power bank, as electricity is limited.
- Mobile phone coverage is unavailable in many areas.
- Camp facilities are basic due to the remote environment.
- Bring cash for personal purchases and gratuities, as card facilities are not available in remote locations.
- Respect the customs and traditions of the Afar people.
- Leave no trace and help protect this unique UNESCO-worthy natural environment.
