### **SOS** ON THE MOVE!

The SOS Committee continues to work toward creating and keeping shady space in our park. We are happy to report that our fundraising efforts are being soundly supported by the RCR park community. Individuals, park organizations and visiting businesses have donated to help us plant new trees in the park. Our Advisory board has come through with a big donation, matching 20% of our total fundraising effort. Thanks for your encouragement as we continue to grow. Checks are even arriving from some who couldn't make it this year but are following us online and through friends! Thanks for getting the word out.

Our fourth order of trees was delivered and planted in March. We will have volunteers taking up the important task of watering our new trees. This is no small contribution as watering a newly planted tree is an enormous commitment. When first planted it is important to water trees daily with a root soaking dose of water until they are able to thrive under natural conditions. The soil must be kept moist during the establishment period so that root hairs will grow into the surrounding soil. After the first month, the watering days gradually taper off for another 4-6 weeks. We are thankful to have people who are working so hard to protect our investment and ensure that our trees are established before we all head out for the summer.

SOS members are excited about another direction we are pursuing too. Some of us are experimenting with raising pine seedlings that have sprouted in the park. Seems like it's a banner year for pine seedlings to sprout here and we have collected and potted several dozen in hopes that eventually we will have our own saplings to plant throughout the park. It's catching on and some residents have even pointed out seedlings growing on their lot that they would like to share. It would be amazing if we can replant areas of the park with our own trees.

I've always been a gardener. I drifted to Butterflies at a very young age; always taking the opportunity to lay on my back and watch the world go by with butterflies around me in a field behind our home in MA.

Fast Forward – the next amazing experience wa a butterfly migration on a beach in Connecticut with THOUSANDS of Monarchs passing by. Butterflies in general I love, but I seem to be drawn to the Monarch Butterfly.

How RCR Butterfly Nursery started to the best of my memory – I was raising butterflies on my own at my site here in RCR, and mentioned the Butterfly Garden to our Manager, Beverly. Bev asked me to show her. Beverly came to Site PT5, and I explained what I was doing within the process of raising Monarchs. Bev asked me if I would be interested in sharing the Butterfly experience with other people here at RCR. With the help of Annie, our Activity Director – Bev and Annie organized "Butterfly Nursery Tours" for the guests and residents of RCR and started the RCR BUTTERFLY NURSERY Facebook Page..

Since the onset of RCR Butterfly Nursery there have been Tours twice a month. Sign up sheets are found in the Lounge. During the Tours I have been able to share my enthusiasm and passion for these beautiful insects. So much so, that now there at least 5 individuals in addition to my site raising Butterflies and spreading information about RCR Butterfly Nursery and how to become a Butterfly Guardian yourself.

The Tours have been amazing, wonderful experiences. Meeting so many different people from all over the country ages from 2 to 90 – has given me a new purpose and goal and has helped myself and others to get through this year's Pandemic with a positive attitude and a renewed love of Nature. What is more amazing is that so many of my tour patrons have gone home to their own residences out of Park and are starting Butterfly Nursery Gardens of their own; raising the awareness of the Monarch Butterfly's plight and helping to re-populate the beautiful Monarch species. What started as a personal hobby for me to keep same through the COVID Pandemic has grown and grown and now we have a Butterfly Community in the Park and Online that allows all to exchange information, plants, seeds, and share the Butterfly Experience with so many.

I have truly enjoyed teaching others about our Butterfly Nursery and am grateful for the opportunity to speak to so many and see the awe in the eyes of the young and the young at heart as they sit among the Butterflies in our Nursery. I will look forward to seeing YOU on one of our upcoming Tours!

Arrive at or after check-in time and leave before check-out time.





#### 1st fiction book - Alone in the Gulf of Mexico

This story begins in Boca Grande, Florida at Uncle Henry's Marina where Pete is trying to teach a Spanish looking gentleman to sail. During the last day of sailing, Captain Pete is hijacked and forced to sail to Merida, Mexico. The story follows the sometimeshectic sailing through storms, waves, and wind as the 21 foot boat makes its way to Mexico. On the way back to Florida Captain Pete discovers a dirty bomb in the bilge of the boat. This story is a continuation of the story from Alone in the Gulf of Mexico. It begins in Illinois but rapidly moves to Florida and eventually to the Gulf of Mexico and Cozumel. The story follows the sometimes-hectic legal battle with individuals from Homeland Security including an unplanned long-distance sail. Along the way there is sailing through storms, waves, and wind with an occasional twist. The continuing interaction between Captain Pete and the Federal Government makes this an enjoyable, yet totally believable read.

#### **3rd fiction book – Captain Pete and the Dry Tortugas**

This fictional story begins in Illinois where Federal Agents propose a rescue mission for Captain Pete and his sailboat, Off the Wind. The story moves to SW Florida with extensive sailing to the Dry Tortugas and a side trip to Cuba. The story continues with the legal battle with the FBI, Homeland Security and even a Presidential Commission. Along the way there is sailing through storms, waves, with an occasional twist. The continuing interaction between Captain Pete and the Federal Government makes this an enjoyable, yet totally believable read. The story is fiction and any reference to politicians currently in office is coincidental.
