COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Council held a regular meeting on June 19, 2023, at the Cree Nation of Eastmain administration office.

CORPORATE AND GOVERNANCE

Council assigned portfolios to the Chief, Deputy Chief and Councillors (see attachment)

Cree Nation Government, Mr. Richard Shecapio, Negotiator and team provided Council a status update on Mining.

Mr. Christopher Beck, Coordinator of Marine Conservation under Cree Nation Government presented to Council the National Marine Conservation Area Feasibility Assessment Project

Dr. Eric Petersen, Department of Biology, Concordia University presented a proposed Fish Study in collaboration with Eeyou Marine Region Wildlife Board on the Eastmain River. Council approved in the principle the proposed Fish Study.
