EASTMAIN BAND CURFEW BY-LAW NO.121


PURSUANT to Sections 45 (1) (d) (iv) of the *Cree-Naskapi (of Québec) Act*, S.C. 1983-84, c.18 (the "Act"), the Eastmain Band, acting through its Council at a meeting of the Council held in Eastmain on September 9th, 1984, hereby enacts the present By-Law respecting curfew on Category IA lands, as Curfew By-Law No.121.

1. In this By-Law, the following words and expressions shall mean:
 - a) "*child*" means a person under sixteen (16) years of age;
 - b) "*parent*" means the father or mother of a child or, as the case may be, the father or mother having custody in law or in fact of the child, or, in absence or failing them, the tutor or guardian in law or in fact of the child, or the person having the care of such child; and
 - c) "*Category IA lands of the Eastmain Band*" is as referred to under Section 2 (1) of the Act.
2. This By-Law shall apply within Category 1A;
3. No child shall be in any place other than his place of residence or in another home with relatives to whom he has been entrusted after ten o'clock P.M. of any day from the end of the school year in June until school resumption in August, and after nine o'clock P.M. every other day of the year, unless such child is in another place with the authorization of his parents;
4. Notwithstanding Article 3 hereof, no child shall be in any public place after ten o'clock P.M. of any day from the end of the school year in June until school resumption in August, and after nine o'clock P.M. every other day of the year, unless such child is accompanied by his or her parents or an adult authorized by such parent to accompany such child;
5. Whenever the provisions of articles 3 or 4 hereof are contravened, a warning shall be given to the child and his parents and, as the case may be, the child shall be conducted forthwith to his or her place of residence.

6. Any parent of a child who permits such child to be in contravention of any of the provisions of this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$50.00;
7. This By-Law shall come into force ten (10) days from the date on which a copy of it has been posted in any public place in Eastmain.
8. This By-Law shall, on the date of its coming into force, repeal and replace all previous Curfew By-Law enacted by the Eastmain Band.
