

Campground Rules & Agreement

Swimming

Guests Swim in the pond & Lake at their own Risk!! NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY!

CHILDREN ARE TO BE MONITORED BY A PARENT AT ALL TIMES IN AND NEAR BODIES OF WATER.

Cancellation Policy

Because of the nature of our small business refunds for camping will only be issued if cancelled within 30 days of day of arrival; however

we are happy to offer a credit for camping to be used within 6 months from time of cancellation. Cancellations within 30 days of Holiday weekends no credit will be issued.

Site Occupancy

Only One RV per site. If you have more than one vehicle please let us know.

If your site only allows room for one vehicle you can park your second vehicle in designated guest parking areas.

Please do not park on the grass if it can be avoided. **No Tent/Primitive Camping on RV sites.**

If you have a guest who would like to tent camp they are welcome to reserve a designated tent site.

Bathhouse

The Bathhouse is open May-August. The Bathhouse is for full time living customers & paying weekend customers only.

Should you have additional guests (other than the couple/household registered as campers) they are to use the showers in your camper. If additional guests/family visiting would like to use the bath house they are welcome to pay \$5 per person (this covers one weekend or two nights use).

Thank you for understanding this helps cover the cost of toiletries, cleaning and utilities used.

Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are daily 10:00pm – 7:00am. Live your life but Please be mindful of excessive, loud noises that may disturb other guests.

Speed Limit

5 miles per hour throughout the park for guests safety.

ATV Vehicles keep to trails, do not drive through high brush/un-mowed areas as these are animal habitats.

Children

Guests are responsible for the behavior of their children. All children under age 12 should be accompanied by an adult at all times, including in the Bath House.

Pet Policy

Swimming

Guests Swim in the pond & Lake at their own Risk. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.

Campfires/Firewood

No outside firewood Permitted due to the risk of invasive Beetle infestation on our timber.

Fallen branches may be gathered and used; there are plenty of trails for this. **Cutting of standing trees or green limbs is strictly prohibited.** Campfires should not be left unattended. No burning treated lumber, diapers or other non-burnables.

Your fire pit is your responsibility to clean out of cigarette butts/cans/trash/etc.

We reserve the right to regulate the size & location of fires and ban campfires when conditions warrant.

Trash

Please place all trash IN A TRASH BAG & then in designated dumpsters. Bicycles, large furniture & other large items are not allowed to be dumped.

Safety After Dark

Flashlights are recommended at dark.

ATVs, golf carts and all vehicles must use headlights.

Visitors Welcome

If you have visitors staying later be sure quiet hours are being kept & their vehicle is in the designated visitor parking.

No Smoking in Certain Areas

No smoking on back trails, the Lake, Pond or by Creek to keep the park clean and hinder risk of brush fire.

Cigarette Butts must be disposed of appropriately, if found scattered at your campground you will be charged a clean up fee.

Damaged or Missing Items

Negligent or intentional Damage to park items/structure is subject to fees. If you think you misplaced/lost an item, please notify us. We keep a lost and found.

Fishing

Fishing is NOT allowed on our creek or small pond. It is for swimming.

Catch & Release ONLY is permitted off the Dam of the Lake only. We don't want people stepping on fishhooks.

You may also fish along the riverbank a block away or at the lake 15 min away.

Trails & Wildlife

Trails may have uneven surfaces. Watch your footing. Stay on the mowed trail. We are not responsible for ticks, poison ivys, rashes, bites & scratches or personal injury. Copperhead & Cottonmouth Snakes are native to this area of Missouri. It is your responsibility to watch your step. Snakes, Lizards, Turtles & other wildlife are NOT to be harmed or moved from places they are found.

Conduct

No illegal drugs, public intoxication that causes a disturbance, possession of alcohol by minors, public displays of nudity and disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. Be courteous of others.

Management

We reserve the right to deny service to any person and to ask anyone to leave the premises at any time should they destroy property, become a nuisance to other guests, involve themselves in disruptive activity and/or fail to apply themselves to the standards we set as a campground after repeated warnings.
