



CAMPGROUND RULES & AGREEMENT

Non- Registered Guests are not permitted and must stop at the Welcome Center to pay for a camping spot or day pass & sign a waiver.

GUESTS SWIM IN THE POND & CREEK AT THEIR OWN RISK! NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY! CHILDREN ARE TO BE MONITORED AT ALL TIMES BY THEIR PARENT/GUARDIAN AND NEAR ALL BODIES OF WATER

Check-In/Check-Out : Check-in at 2:00. Check-out is 11:00am.

Cancellation

Because of the nature of our business no refunds are offered for missed/cancelled reservations. We are happy to apply a credit to camp another weekend to be used within a years time.

Site Occupancy

All guests other than guests registered on reservation must be noted upon check in.
No Tent/Primitive Camping on RV sites.
Tent Campers must make a separate reservation in a designated tent site.

Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are daily 10:00pm – 7:00am.

Speed Limit

5 miles per hour throughout the park.

Children

Guests are responsible for the behavior of their children & underage persons they bring or invite.

All children under age 12 should be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Bathhouse

Thank you for ensuring our bathhouse treated with respect. All children using the boathouse should be accompanied by a parent.

Swimming

Guests Swim at their own Risk. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. You are responsible for ensuring all children are monitored in and around bodies of water & exercising safe play.

Pet Policy

Pets must remain on a leash, including the swimming area. All pets must be noted upon check- in. Animals shall not disturb the peace or be a nuisance to other guests. No vicious dogs or aggressive breeds such as Pit Bulls aloud.

Fireworks

No fireworks at any time or season. No exceptions.

Picnic Tables & Fire Pits

One picnic table & One fire pit are provided per campsite.

Campfires/Firewood

No outside firewood Permitted. Outside firewood brings the risk of Invasive Beetle species to our acreage & Nature Exploratory. Fallen branches may be gathered and used. Cutting of standing trees or green limbs is strictly prohibited. Campfires should not be left unattended.

Trash

Please place all trash in a trash bag & then in designated dumpsters located on the road at exit.

After Dark

Flashlights are recommended at dark. ATVs, golf carts and all vehicles must use headlights at night.

Smoking

Keep smoking to your designated camp site only. No smoking on trails or by pond or creek. Cigarette Butts may be disposed of via burning in your fire ring.

Missing Items

If you think you misplaced/lost an item, please notify us. We keep a lost and found.

Fishing

Catch & release on the pond is welcome on the dam & dock only. NO Fishing off the shores. You may fish along the riverbank a block away also.

Trails & Wildlife

Trails may have uneven surfaces. Watch your footing. Stay on the mowed trail. We are not responsible for ticks, poison ivys, rashes, bites & scratches or personal injury. Copperhead & Cottonmouth Snakes are native to this area of Missouri. It is your responsibility to watch your step. Snakes, Lizards, Turtles & other wildlife are NOT to be harmed & please put them back where you found them.

Conduct

No illegal drugs, public intoxication, possession of alcohol by minors, public displays of nudity and disorderly conduct will be tolerated. Be courteous of others. No crossing through occupied campsites.

Management

Kimmys At Caplinger is a private campground. We reserve the right to deny service to any person and to ask anyone to leave the premises at any time. No refunds will be given. Management is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Camping & Outdoor activity Risks & Liability

As you choose to participate in outdoor activities including but not limited to occupying a campsite amongst nature you acknowledge you understand we are not liable for damage to oneself or personal property; including your camper or vehicle, by acts of involving yourself in & amongst nature such as excessive rain, falling limbs or trees, uneven surfaces that come with being in nature, bites from wild animals or snakes, scratches, bumps or bruises or breaks you may acquire when participating in outdoor activities such as camping. This includes acknowledging your personal liability for participating in water related activities such as swimming, fishing or kayaking, including your personal responsibility to monitor, care for and keep your children safe on our land and near or on any bodies of water. **There is NO LIFEGUARD on duty and being around or in any body of water on our property you take on the personal risks for yourselves and your children that comes with engaging in such activity.**
