Policy Highlight...

AUTHORIZED PERSONS FOR PICK UP AND EMERGENCY CONTACT

Children will only be released to parents, guardians, and persons whose names appear on the Authorized Persons for Pick Up/Emergency Contact List. All children dropped off and picked up must be accompanied by someone that is 18 years of age or older. Persons who have been authorized to pick up your child must first stop at the front desk and present a valid photo I.D. The center must have on file a list of names, addresses, and phone numbers of emergency contacts. The emergency contacts are persons in the area who are authorized by the parent(s) to pick up and/or care for the child in case of illness or emergency when the parent cannot be reached.

Please inform all authorized persons that staff members will ask for photo identification of any persons with whom they are not familiar. If you will not be at the number you have listed to contact you during your child's day at school, leave a note with the Director with the number at which you can be reached, or notify us by phone before the person comes to pick the child up.

Please update the authorized pick-up information form as soon as you are aware of changes. It is your responsibility to update the authorized pick-up or emergency contact information. All changes must be made in writing.
