Policy Highlight

PAYMENTS

The center accepts payments through Brightwheel and Zelle.

All tuition payments are due in advance on Monday. A late fee of \$25.00 will be added to your account if your payment remains unpaid after Wednesday morning. If your tuition remains unpaid for more than one week, your child will be excluded from attendance until your account is current, including late fees. There is no refund for **absences or holidays**.

We reserve the right to remove a child from the school for non-payment, or for **payments that are not made on time continually**.

You are entitled to one vacation week of waived tuition per calendar year, 6 months after enrollment. Weekly tuition payments are still required to maintain your child's enrollment, whether they are in attendance or not.
