Policy Highlight...

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

All children must have obtained the minimum necessary immunizations required by state law prior to enrollment and must remain current on their immunizations in order to continue attending school.

Parents must produce records showing (1) that the child has been immunized in accordance with the rules; (2) the child has an exemption from immunization requirements in accordance with the rules; or (3) that the child is entitled to provisional enrollment.

Acceptance documentation of immunizations is any record of immunizations validated by a physician or his/her designee, or public health personnel. The record must show the month, day, and year when each immunization was received.
