

Policy Highlight...

CLOTHING AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS

We ask that all clothing be weather appropriate for school. Mark any removable clothing accessories, and any other items brought to the school with your child's name. In order to ensure that unlabeled items are returned to the appropriate child, the teacher may write the child's name in them with a permanent marker.

In order to encourage independence in young children, please dress them in clothing that is easy for them to manage on their own, such as elastic waistbands, or beltless pants.

Children are encouraged to wear closed toe shoes to prevent injuries to their feet. Girls are required to wear shorts under their dresses.

We ask that you leave at least two complete outfits for your child here at school in case of an accident, including underwear and socks.

Tuesday, September 22nd, don't forget to wear your favorite Fall color: Red, Orange, Yellow, or Brown.

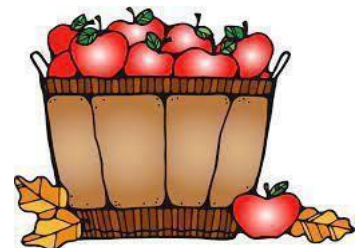
