# 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Robert J. Black Youth Open Tournament

## 2020 RULES AND FORMAT

**CERTIFICATION:** This tournament is certified through Caldwell USBC

**ELIGIBILITY:** All entrants must be a current Youth USBC Member.

**PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY:** Each bowling establishment is responsible for providing proof of average and membership of all bowlers, with a minimum of 21 games.

**DIVISIONS:** There are 4 divisions, 2 Boy and 2 girl (or more) divisions. Each division is divided by age, as of August 1, 2019 established by USBC divisions Bantam/ prep and Jr/Sr/Major. All Divisions will bowl handicap.

Division A, Boy Bantam and Prep

Division B, Girl Bantam and Prep

Division C, Boy Jr/Sr and Major

Division D, Girl Jr/Sr and Major

**ENTRY FEES:** The entry fee will be \$40.00 per bowler for the tournament (\$30.00 for scholarship fund, \$10.00 lineage (which will be donated back as additional scholarships from the house))

**INDIVIDUAL AWARDS:** Everyone that bowls in the finals will be eligible for an award.

**INDIVIDUAL SCHOLARSHIPS:** Everyone that bowls the finals will receive a scholarship.

All scholarships will be awarded through the SMART Program.

**DRESS CODE:** Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, and illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. No jeans or pants with holes. Any deviation from the dress code must be approved by a tournament director prior to the start of the tournament.

**CONDUCT & BEHAVIOR:** Bowlers are expected to act and look like young professionals.

**FORMAT:** Each bowler will bowl 3 games at Caldwell Bowl both days. All awards will be based on 6 game handicap scores (individual) 3 games (team)

**HANDICAP:** handicap is 90% of 230.

**AVERAGES:** Averages will be based on January 1, 2020.

The tournament Director will have final decision regarding tournament play, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC/705.
