Youth Confirmation Class:

Fall means "back to school," for the children of our own preschool and for our congregational children. It also means "back to spiritual school" for our middle school youth, as CONFIRMATION CLASSES will begin on Sunday, September 11. That's the Sunday AFTER Labor Day weekend.

Youth in grades 6-8 are welcomed to participate, meeting from 9:45 to 10:45 each Sunday morning in the church office. Pastor Nieting will be leading the classes. Youth are expected to bring their Bible, their catechism, and arrive promptly. Memory work and other homework will be assigned regularly.

This year Pastor Nieting will also require "sermon summaries" from each student, twice a month. Forms for this will be provided in the narthex. This is to encourage our confirmands to participate in worship with the Body of Christ and grow in faith from God's Word.
