#### **Giving Opportunities:**

When you give with envelopes or online, you may wonder what the different Funds are for. Following is an explanation of PoP's giving programs and how they enable PoP to carry out its mission, maintain operations, and undertake new projects.

-General Fund: Covers day-to-day operating expenses as per the annually approved Spending Plan (e.g., worship aids, utilities, salaries).

-All to the Glory / Building Fund: Used for all building and site capital & maintenance expenses \$3,000+ (e.g., parking lot paving, window replacement).

Next Gen Fund: Supports long term future facility improvements (e.g., additions, renovations).

Trustees Fund: Covers emergency repair costs under \$3,000. Trustees are authorized to use these funds without prior approval from the congregation.

Memorial Fund: Receives funds in memory of loved ones and supports various worship items and Church grounds.

Large Print Ministry: Supports the creation of large print Bibles and other religious materials for the sight impaired.

Vacation Bible School: Supports PoP's annual VBS program. Questions? Please see Brian Houck, Treasurer.
