The Excess funds from 2022 general fund income is \$17,351.00.

The council suggests we disburse the excess funds as follows: 10% to missions (\$1,735.00), Web site (\$2,500.00), Keyboard for 2nd service (\$1,000.00), Next gen fund (\$2,000.00), All to the Glory (\$2,000.00), Parking lot (\$8,116.00)

This can be approved as is or adjusted by the congregation.

LCMS Synod Officer Elections and Convention:

Every three years the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod (LCMS), holds a Convention which includes election of Synod Officers and amendments to the LCMS Constitution and Bylaws (Overtures). Pastor Russell Graef was selected to be a Pastoral delegate to the Synod Convention by our Church Circuit. The Synod Convention runs from July 29, 2023 to August 1, 2023 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. LCMS recommended nominations for the Synod President and Vice President may be found at the below link:

LCMS offers the opportunity for each Church in LCMS to nominate President or Vice President candidates. Up to two nominations per Church are allowed for each position. To nominate a Pastor from another Church, you must first contact that Pastor, obtain his permission, Church information, address, contact information, and short bio. The Church Office has an LCMS directory for your use, if you need to look up a Pastor. If you are nominating the East/Southeast Regional Vice President, that Pastor must be a resident of that region. We will discuss nominations during a Congregational Voters Meeting in February 2023. The deadline for our Church to submit LCMS Synod Officer nominations is **February 28, 2023**.
