After 8 months with Relume Co. as a Retail and Production Assistant, I was additionally given the role as Artist-in-Residence. In my new role, I collaborate with the management team to conceptualize and develop original in-house products such as laser cut acrylic earrings, stickers and prints for both retail and wholesale, as well as design and construct immersive, whimsical window and in-store displays and social media graphics. Tasks include conducting trend research using platforms like Shopify, Pinterest, and TikTok to inform product and display design and prototyping, managing budgets, sourcing materials and equipment, rendering graphic designs for prints, stickers, earrings, etc using Canva, and Adobe suite, fabricating both new products and handmade window displays, as well as shop furniture such as shelving and displays and leading seasonal display installation processes with support from the retail team. I also am still responsible for the retail and production tasks outlined previously.
