

The Scout Uniform

A Scout is "in Class A uniform" when s/he wears the four parts of the uniform. The complete official uniform includes:

- Scout long-sleeved or short-sleeved shirt with epaulets
- Scout pants or shorts
- Scout belt and buckle
- Scout socks or knee socks

Class B uniform consists of the Troop shirt, Scout pants or shorts, and an optional scouting cap. For outdoor activities, Scouts may wear Class B or other appropriate attire.
