- > High school diploma or equivalent, or university/college degree from a school using the assessed language.
- > 5 or more years of verified professional experience working in the languages being assessed.
- > State or federal court interpreter certification.
- > Oral language exam results with scores equivalent to ACTFL Advanced Mid-level or ILR Level 2.


If applicants do not have any prior proof of language proficiency, the registration process will include a 30 minute speaking and listening assessment conducted online. This test may be taken remotely through Language Testing International (LTI). Call us for assistance in setting up an appointment with LTI or go online to reserve your exam time (www.languagetesting.com). Remote testing at your home can be arranged for a fee of \$125.
