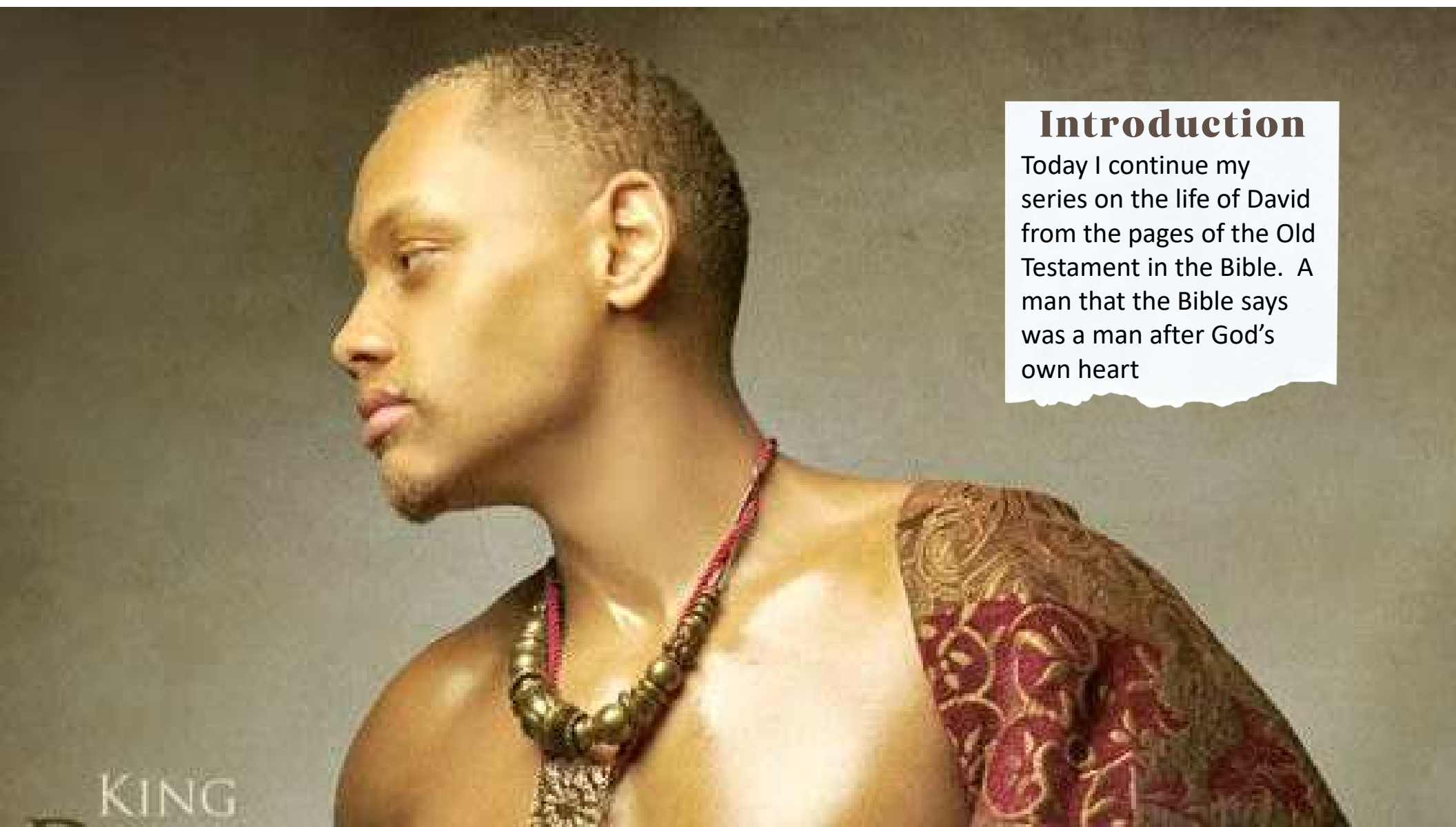

Today I continue my series on the life of David from the pages of the Old Testament in the Bible. A man that the Bible says was a man after God's own heart



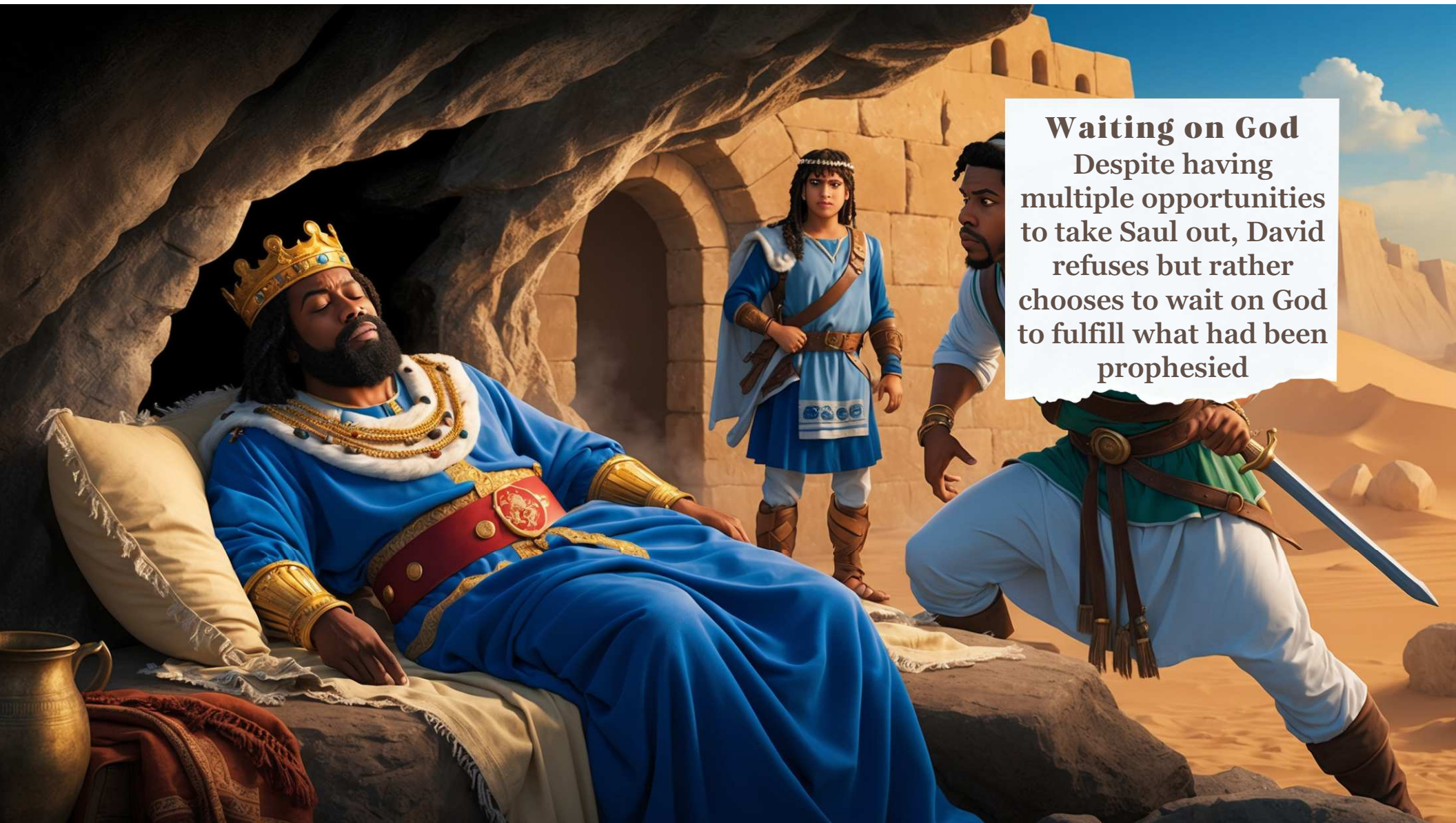


Success and Fame

When they return the people sing a song that says Saul has killed his thousands while David has killed his tens of thousands



Envy Turns Deadly
Saul is consumed with jealousy to the point that he attempts to take David's life even after having befriended the prince Jonathan and marry the king's daughter



Waiting on God

Despite having multiple opportunities to take Saul out, David refuses but rather chooses to wait on God to fulfill what had been prophesied
