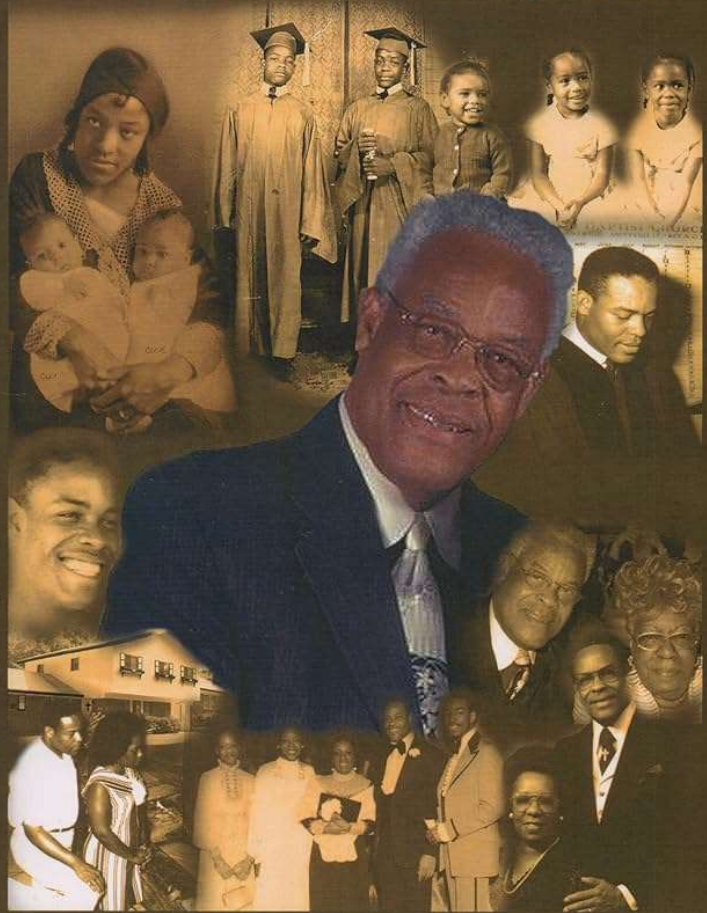

At Birth

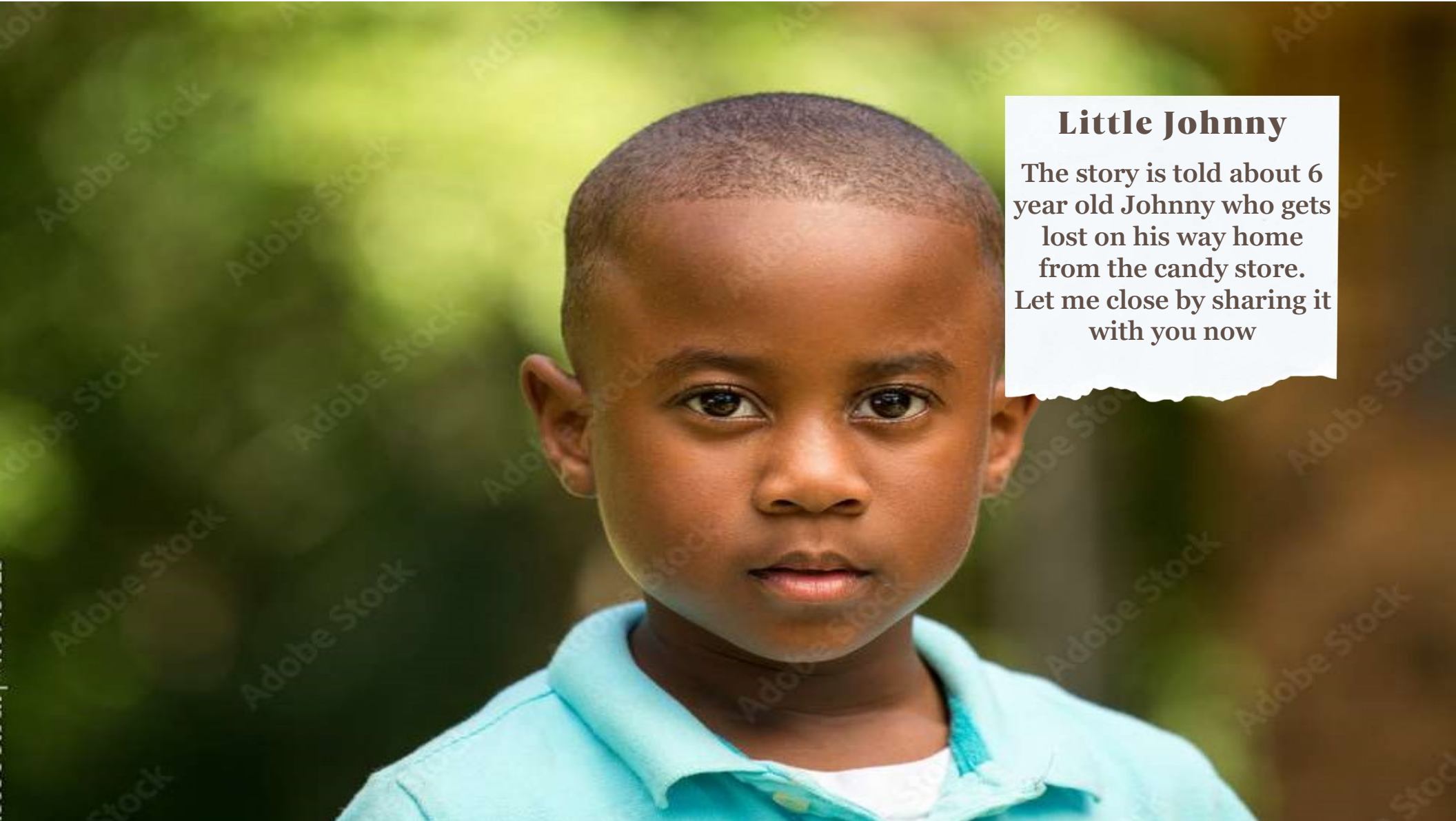
All of my life our family was told of the doctor who delivered my father placing he and his brother in the arms of his mother and predicting that one would be a doctor and the other a minister
