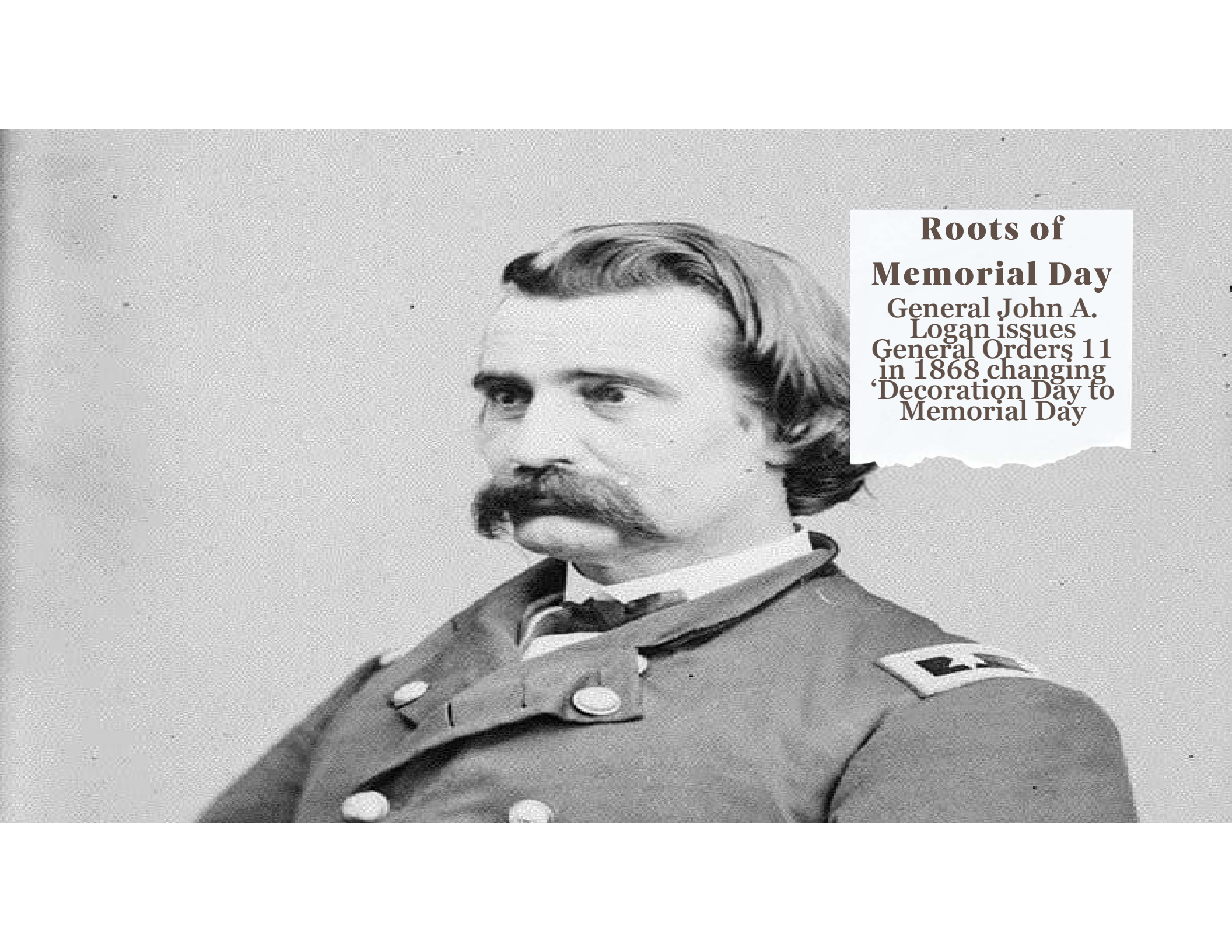

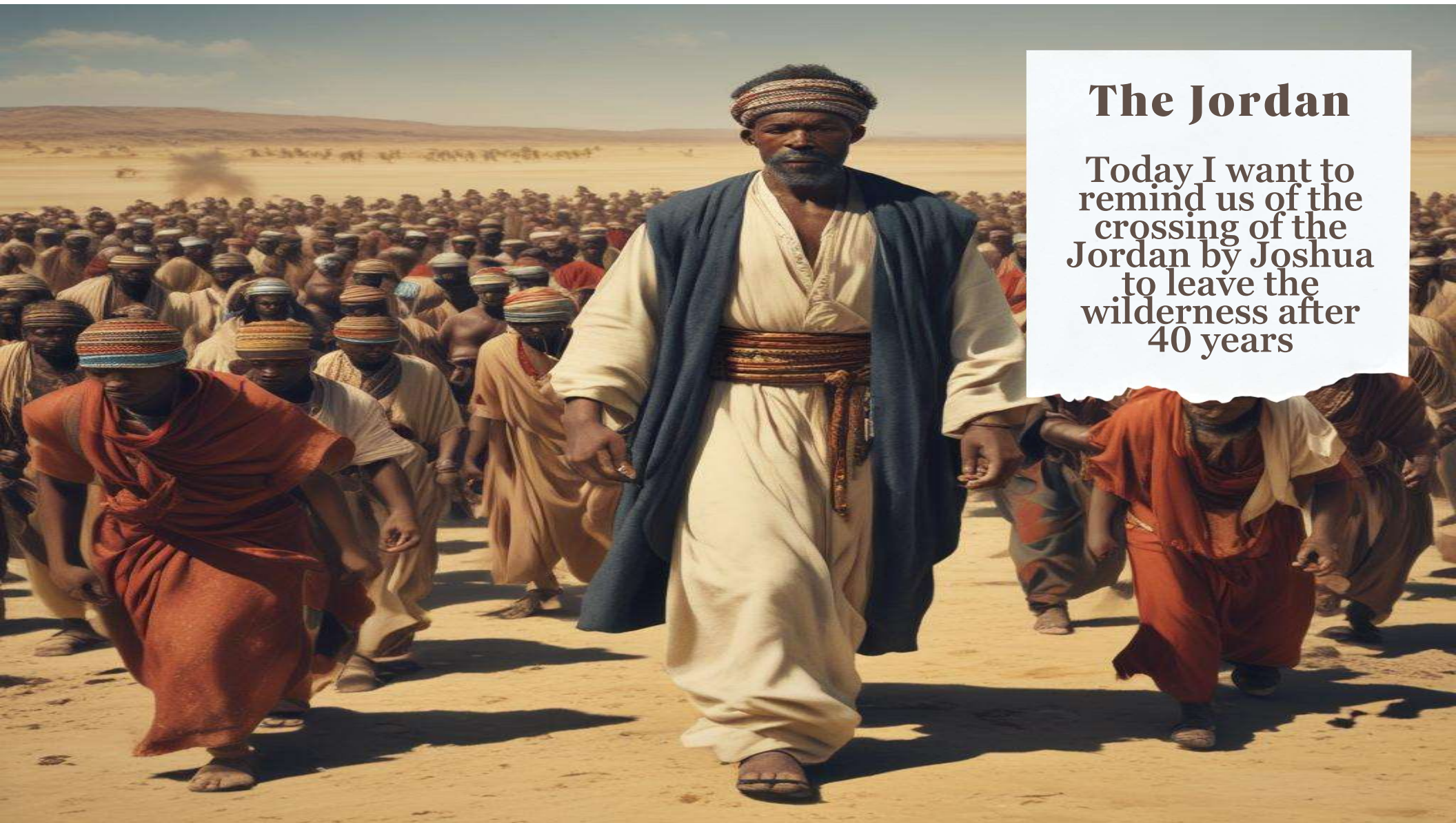

years



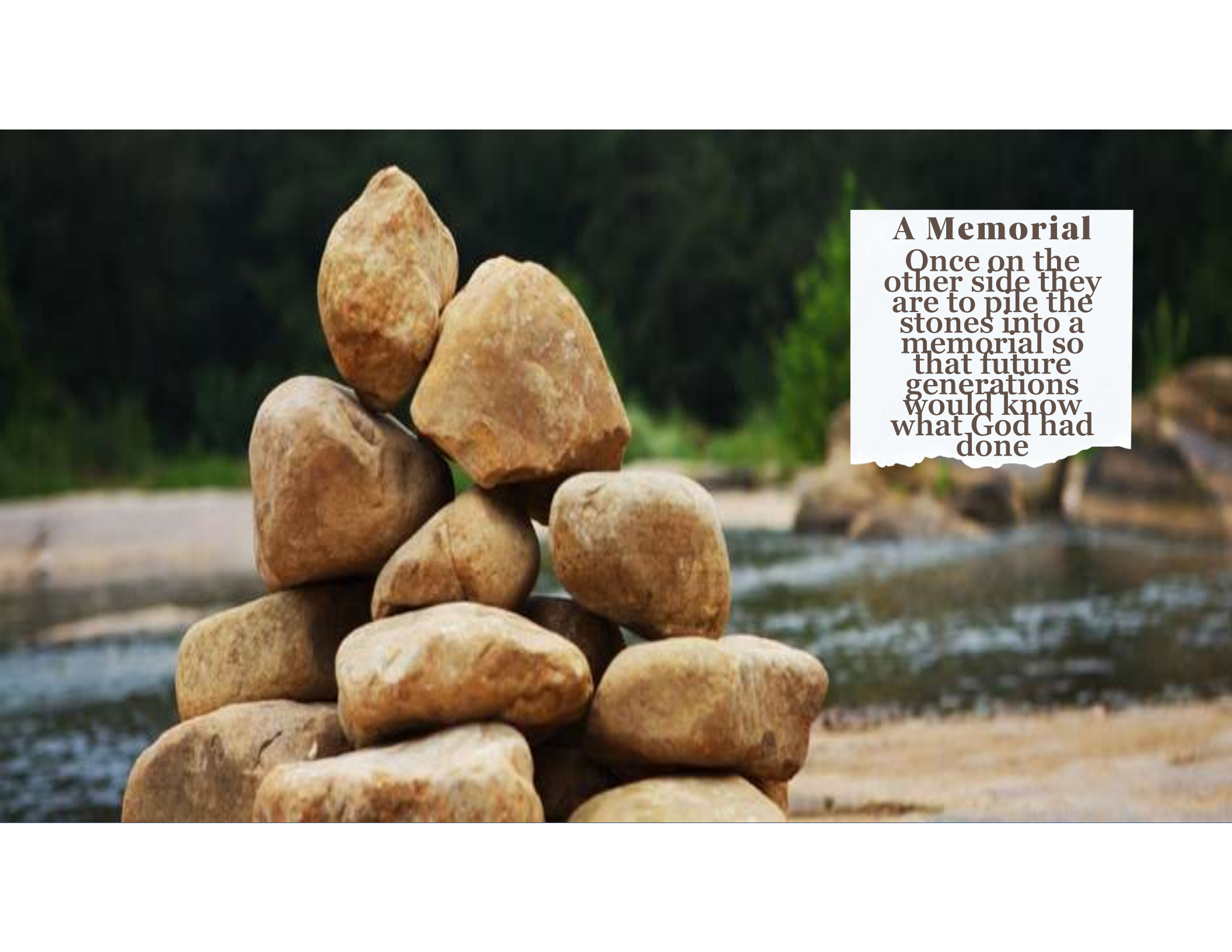
The Jordan
