- We are created to have a spirit dwell in us we will choose which spirit.
- How big is the Holy Spirit? Do you want the Holy Spirit (as presented) dwelling in you?

The Spirit of Christ

The Spirit of the Father

The Spirit of God

The Spirit of Jesus



- Whatever Jesus did, the Holy Spirit wants to duplicate in us, and live through us. We can expect from the Holy Spirit whatever we see in Jesus.
- The greatness of faith isn't measured by what you receive, but by how long you can wait before you receive it.
- In Greek: Another word for "atmosphere" is spirit.
- The Holy Spirit is a person Who proceeds from the Father and the Son and brings with Him all of the Holiness of the Father and all of the Holiness of the Son.
- When you are filled with the Holy Spirit, the things of God within you will make perfect sense.
- When you are filled with the Holy Spirit, commandments aren't necessary.
- When the Holy Spirit comes, the place of your failure will be the launching point of the greatest victory you could ever imagine.
- A fruit tree (or vine) never eats its own fruit.
- The greatest gift, if having fruit to give to others.
