As we continue with our outreach efforts, here are the items we are asking for the month of October. Remember that we will take any items you want to bring in so keep them coming.

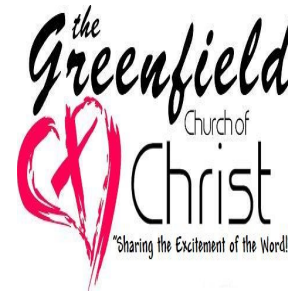

We are putting out the large jug again to collect donations for Hippo Valley Missions Christmas Wish program. Last year they launched a very successful program with a handful of churches participating. This year they are hoping for even more participation from supporting churches. This is an opportunity to provide new school uniforms for poor children in Zimbabwe Africa as a Christmas gift. Most of these kids have never received new clothes or shoes in their life. For \$35, we can provide a new school uniform, socks and shoes for one of the 21,000 children attending the mission schools. We will be taking donations until December 1. If you write a check, make it out to our church, Greenfield Church of Christ, and we will send one check once all the money has been counted.

We can be thankful for the opportunities to serve the LORD through our outreach efforts, and I know the LORD will bless each and every person for their service. Paul praised the Corinthian church in 1 Corinthians 8:3 when he said, "For I can testify that they gave not only what they could, but far more. And they did it of their own free will."
