Christ Church Clifton - Open Church & Guided Tours

Guided tours running at 11:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30, 13:00, 13:30 - just turn up a few minutes early.

Step inside Christ Church Clifton and discover the fascinating story of this much-loved Bristol landmark. For a few hours, we'll be opening the church for anyone to come and look around, but also offering free guided tours, giving visitors the opportunity to explore its history and architecture in more detail.

Each 30-minute tour includes:

- A brief history of the church over the past 150 years.
- Stories from its construction and how it survived the Bristol Blitz.
- The chance to see the beautiful stained glass windows and large pipe organ.
- How the building has been sensitively modernised while remaining true to its original design.
- Visit the renovated crypt which is frequently used by the community.
- Hear about some of the church's hidden spaces.
- An opportunity to pray or request prayer.

There is plenty of space to sit, relax and enjoy the welcoming atmosphere of the church. Whether you're joining a tour, taking a quiet moment, or simply dropping in to look around, we'd love to welcome you to Christ Church Clifton on Clifton Village Day.

Please note: The church tower and spire are not accessible during the tours.

Accessibility: The tours are suitable for everyone. The main church can be accessed via a ramp, and lift access is available to the toilets. Inside the church, there are a few areas that can only be accessed by steps but this will not affect your enjoyment of the tour which will be focusing on other areas of the building.
