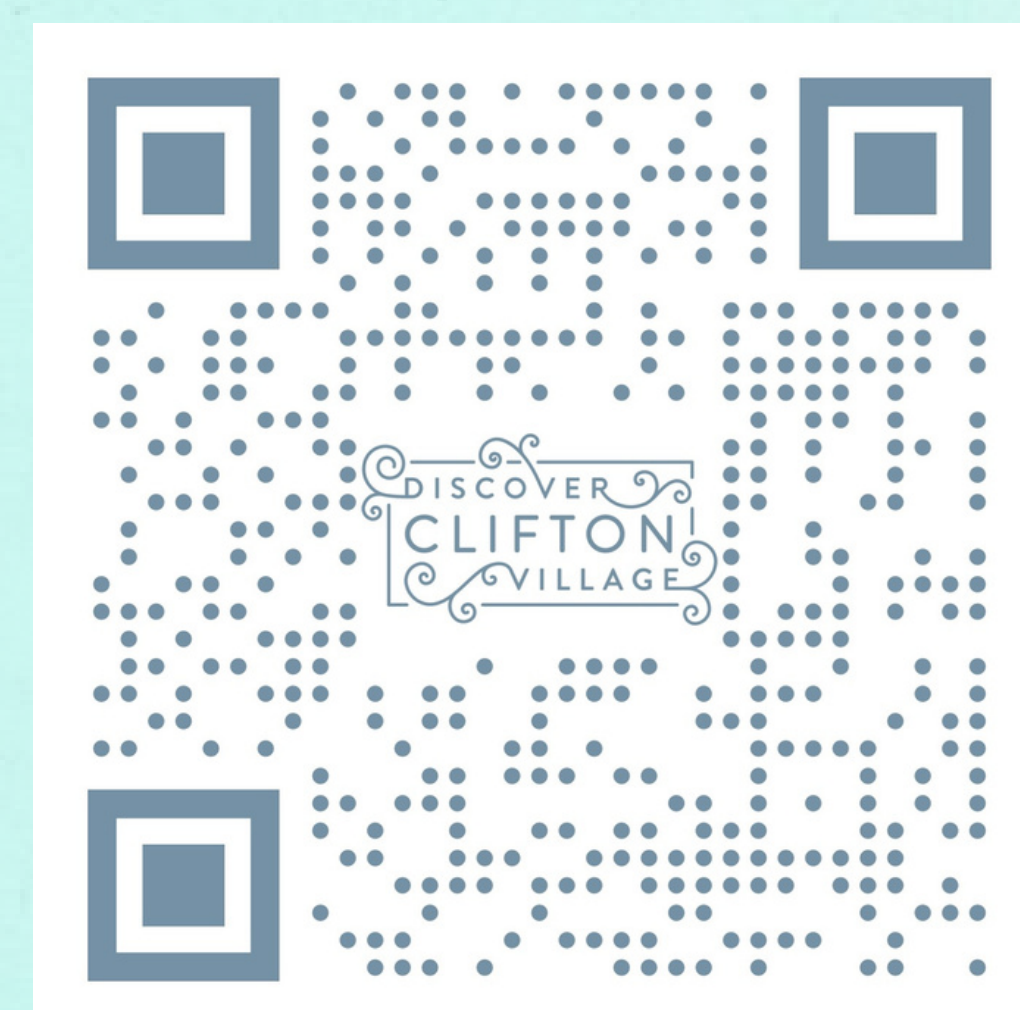


THE CLIFTON SUSPENSION BRIDGE

The Clifton Suspension Bridge was designed by Isambard Kingdom Brunel, it is the symbol of the city of Bristol. For over 150 years this Grade 1 listed structure has attracted visitors from all over the world.

The bridge connects Bristol to North Somerset and is owned and operated by the Clifton Suspension Bridge Trust. It is entirely funded by tolls - which have paid for it's upkeep since it first opened to the public on 8th December 1864.
