The Clifton Suspension Bridge was designed by Isambard Kingdom Brunel, it is the symbol of the city of Bristol. For over 150 years this Grade 1 listed structure has attracted visitors from all over the world.

The bridge connects Bristol to Brunel Somercot and is owned and operated by the Clifton Suspension Bridge Trust.

It is entirely funded by tells - which have paid for it's upkeep since it first opened to the public on 25th December 1864.
