Hello April!

We are starting our show activities this month with our Studio Photo Day on Sunday 19th April with AP Photography. A few important reminders for Photo Day:

- Wear appropriate underwear (nude/white and clear straps on bras).

After her time at Shockout Miss Chloe wanted to push her career into teaching full time and now works to inspire other individuals in their future dance career and to discover their own unique voices.
