## SCANE DANCE CODE OF CONDUCT



Scane Dance is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all our students, teachers and volunteers associated with the school. To ensure the effective running of Scane Dance and to protect all individuals connected with the school it is important that the following codes of conduct are read, respected and adhered to at all times.

## **Teachers Code of Conduct**

Inspire, motive and support each student to reach their fullest potential within a safe, happy and stimulating learning environment. Promote the value of progression and achievement by planning lessons that build on the current attributes and level of ability.

Always consider the students physical, motor and psychological abilities by using diverse teaching methods to suit a range of learners, including those with additional learning needs (ALN), whilst implementing the principles of fairness, equality and respect.

Safeguarding of the student's well-being is of utmost importance, treating all students, and their families, with dignity and mutual respect, welcoming everyone equally. Promote respectful and courteous behaviour by all in the school and take appropriate disciplinary actions when needed, to maintain a positive environment with students' best interests placed first.

Remain up to date with any developments in the dance profession and attend annual CPDs specifically for Acro and IDTA syllabi and their varied curriculums, promoting the value of progression and good teaching standards.

## Students Code of Conduct

- Students must participate within the school rules and respect all the teachers and their decisions.
- Arrive for classes on time or inform the Dance Teacher if they are going to be late.
- Students must not distract, bully or harass other students during the class.
- Students must not use bad language.
- Students must be polite and display good manners at all times.
- Treat all equipment with respect.
- All body jewellery must be removed.
- Long hair must be tied back.
- All litter must be placed in the bins provided.
- Mobile phones and other electronic devices must not be brought into class.
- Inform the teacher before the warm up begins if they have an injury or illness.
- Students must inform their teacher immediately if they begin to feel ill or sustain an injury.
- Remain with teachers at the end of the class until they are safely collected by their parent/ guardian.
- Attend class ready in full uniform with correct footwear for the genre.

## Parents / Guardians Code Of Conduct

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and perform within them.
- Arrive with plenty of time to get your child ready for their class.
- Always ensure your child is dressed appropriately with long hair tied up.
- No Parent/Guardian will be allowed into the studio during classes unless invited in.
- Discourage inappropriate conduct towards teachers and other students.
- Help your child to recognise good performance and progression.
- Use correct language at all times.
- Guide your child to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Keep the teacher informed if your child is ill or unable to attend classes.
- Never challenge or threaten a teacher or member of the Scane Dance team.
- Do not raise issues of disagreement publicly.
- Always collect your child promptly at the end of a class.
- All fees must be paid on time otherwise you risk losing your child's place in class.
- Always support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their classes.

Please understand that breach of this code of conduct may have repercussions and in extreme cases may result in your child losing their place at the school.
