You will be asked questions about your work/creative process at sessions end. Physically bring **5 to 7 priced** items representing your art or craft to your scheduled session for review.

All sessions are held in the Library of Haycock Township Community Center. Your items will be examined by our panel, and you will be notified either immediately afterward or withing a week of the session. Our committee carefully considers factors such as uniqueness, salability, neat presentation, and reasonable price points for our market before making our decisions. Each year, former participants are asked back first. Those who choose not to participate are replaced by new vendors who we feel will help balance our show's content. Additionally, our panel may be able to help you by suggesting insightful marketing strategies. If you are entering a variety of genre types, some items may be accepted while others may not. We hope your experience with us is always positive and beneficial as we want to promote *your* talent as a local resident as well as succeed as a fund-raising event for Haycock Historical Society.

*Please note: If accepted, we will make every effort to ensure care and safety handling your handiwork. However, the Haycock Historical Society, coordinators, township groups or officials will not be held responsible for damaged or stolen items. The Haycock Historical Society retains 25% of the sale of all items up to \$2000. After which, 20% will be deducted. You will also be required to pay a non-refundable application fee of \$75 for the three-day show. You may be able to reduce this fee by \$20.00 by committing to help at a specific shift before, during or after the event.

Directions to Haycock Township Community Center

From North of Quakertown & Richlandtown: Take Rte 212 N. through Richlandtown, turn right in front of St. Johns church, passing Meadow Lane on right & Younken Rd on left. Pullen Station is the next road on the right. Follow Pullen Station to its end. Turn right onto Old Bethlehem Road. Kringle Shoppe is ½ mile on the left at the intersection of East and West Sawmill Roads, at the former Haycock Elementary School, now Haycock Township Community Center.

From Doylestown: Take Rte 611 North to Rte 412 above Ottsville. Turn left onto Rte 563
Travel about 7 miles. Turn right on to Old Bethlehem Road at Becker's Corner Restaurant & Sports Bar. Travel North on Old Bethlehem Road, 3.5 miles. Kringle is held at the Haycock Township Community Center at the intersection of Old Bethlehem and East/West Sawmill Road.

From Perkasie: Take Rte 313 North to Rte 563 (Mountainview Drive). Turn right onto 563 and travel north about 2 miles to Becker's Corner Restaurant & Sports Bar. Travel North on Old Bethlehem Road, 3.5 miles. Kringle is held at the Haycock Township Community Center at the intersection of Old Bethlehem and East/West Sawmill Road.
