In the entire history of the Catholic Church, there have been numerous Eucharistic miracles approved by the Church as truly worthy of belief. The earliest documented Miracle was in **Lanciano**, **Italy** around **750 A.D. The Vatican Eucharistic Miracles Photographic Exhibition** faithfully recounts that miracle and many other well documented miraculous events. Knowledge of these miracles strengthens our faith in Christ and His Holy Church and becomes an excellent tool for evangelization. These miracles are visible proofs of Jesus Christ's Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. Many of these same miracles went through various scientific investigations and many discoveries such as matching blood types and living heart tissue still amaze exhibit viewers today!

The St. Carlo Acutis Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit will be displayed for viewing at Assumption Grotto Parish this coming July 12th through August 24th. Our open viewing hours are on Saturdays and Sundays each week from 10am-3pm. There will also be hours during the week set aside for group conferences available by appointment. 
