In Defense of Catholicism



Athanasius Schneider is the auxiliary bishop of Astana, Kazakhstan and a member of the Canons Regular of the Holy Cross He was born in 1961 in the USSR of German parents sent to the Gulag after WWII. His mother was active in the underground church. Under communism, his family took the train once a month 60 miles to attend Mass. He was ordained a priest on March 25, 1990 and ordained a bishop in 2006.

He is the author of *Dominus Est!* and the interview book *Christus Vincit*:


