General Board Meeting

March 9, 2026

Via Zoom

Board members in attendance: Joan Fulton, President; Crystal Wentz, 1st Vice President and Co-chair 30th Anniversary Committee; Pat Baker, VP Programs; Ellen Rankin, Treasurer; Jane Rozum, Website and Integration; Cyndy Marquez, Secretary; Beth Soderquist, Web Communications; Charlotte Cox, Hospitality; Lauri Dykstra, Retreat Coordinator; Sue Ellis, Co-chair Membership; Kathy Winter, Ways and Means; Sue Hine, Newsletter; Laretta Oudeman, Show and Tell; Kaea Beresford, Publicity; Julie Aanonson, Small Groups Coordinator.

1. Joan Fulton (“Joan”) welcomed everyone to the General Board meeting.
2. The following Minutes were reviewed:
 - a. General Meeting – February 2, 2026;
 - b. General Meeting – March 2, 2026; and
 - c. General Board Meeting – February 9, 2026.

Motion by Jane Rozum (“Jane”) to approve all listed Minutes; seconded by Crystal Wentz (“Crystal”). Board Members verbally approved the listed Minutes.

3. Joan discussed the Treasurer’s report that had been circulated in advance of the Board meeting. She noted that this is a work-in-progress. Formatting is being reviewed so that this report may be presented at general membership as required. Joan also reported that the audit committee is complete and will be tasked with verifying financials as well as reviewing policies and procedures.
4. 30th Anniversary Celebration – July 13th at the Best Western is now confirmed. The Committee consists of Joan, Lauri Dykstra (“Lauri”) and Sheree Cook.
5. Quilted Forest – possible April workday to be scheduled.
6. Joint Quilt Show with Front Range Contemporary Quilters (“FRCQ”) – Joan met with members of FRCQ and plans for a joint show are moving forward. Gallery

space in Lafayette is being considered and with dates one-to-two years in the future. FRCQ membership is mostly art quilters and this show is anticipated to include both art and traditional quilts in wall hanging size to comply with gallery space. Theme may be a color.


7. Kid's Camp with Rocky Mountain Quilt Museum ("RMQM") – plans moving forward for a Kid's Camp this summer. RMQM would provide curriculum, training and use of their sewing machines if there is no date conflict. LNCQ would handle registration. Camp would include up to eight kids, ages 8-15, for 5-days from 9am-3pm and cost \$400 per child. Fabric to be donated. Dates will be July 20-24 at the Best Western, utilizing a partial ballroom space. Approximately six volunteers and fabric donations will be needed; estimating one volunteer per child plus floaters. Program would include snacks and an ice cream social on the last day. If this program is successful, grants might be available for future years.
8. Website – Executive Board passed a motion to allow LNCQ website to be accessed without a password except for member information which would require a single password for all members. A Website re-fresh is in the works. Joan expressed appreciation for all the work Jane and Beth Soderquist have done.
9. VP Programs – Pat Baker reported that scheduling of 2027 programs is continuing with a few openings remaining. She noted the PowerPoint presentation at the past general meeting.
10. 1st VP – Crystal reported on her continued work with Best Western on contracts including the Kid's Camp dates.
11. Community Service – Betty Ann Eash was not present but provided a report in advance; a copy of the email is attached.
12. Newsletter – Sue Hine reported that the March newsletter will go out to all. Members that have not yet renewed for 2026 will not receive any further newsletters. Joan will provide the PowerPoint presentation of upcoming programs for posting in the newsletter.
13. Hospitality – Charlotte Cox noted that despite sending out emails, no one brought snacks to the general meeting. Evening meetings seem to be harder to get snacks than day meetings. It was suggested that Board Members might fill in as needed.
14. Publicity - Kaea Beresford reported that the March newsletter will contain a link for LNCQ members to vote on whether to keep the existing logo or change to he

new logo design. Following the outcome, publicity cards will be ordered. 30th Anniversary notices are in progress.

15. Retreats Coordinator - Lauri Dykstra noted that approximately 26 members have signed up for the April retreat in RMNP so LNCQ has met the room obligation. The in-town retreat at the Best Western has been scheduled for June 15-16.
16. Show and Tell - Loretta Oudeman reported that the May Show and Tell program will include the Round Robin quilts and this needs to be included in the newsletter. The Show and Tell forms now include the name of the quilter if different than the piecer. Discussion of editing and posting of Show and Tell photos.
17. Ways and Means - Kathy Winter reported that the garage sale is scheduled for June 6th to coincide with the Wellington community sale event. She can accept donations starting in March with large items to be delivered the weekend before. 3-4 volunteers are needed to help with set up, pricing and during the sale. A work day could be scheduled the day before the sale. The newsletter could advertise the need for donations and Jane could add the sale to the website.
 - a. Tee shirts - tee's with the new logo are being researched as well as long-sleeved tee's or sweatshirts. A few of last year's tee's remain.
 - b. Holiday silent auction may be back by popular demand. Special items donated to the garage sale could be re-routed to the auction.
