

Sliced Layer Cake – Lap Size (49" x 73")

Materials

- Half a layer cake (20 10" squares)
- 2 5/8 yards background/sashing fabric

Cutting

- Layer cake (20 fabric squares 10" square), cut into 5" x 10" pieces
- Background fabric
 - (5) 5" strips, sub-cut into 5" squares (40 needed)
 - (21) 2" strips WOF. Make into vertical sashing strips and borders

Sewing the blocks

- Sew a 5" square of background to a 5" x 10" piece of layer cake fabric
- Repeat for a total of 40 units
- Sew 5 units into a column. Repeat for a total of 8 columns

Assembling the quilt

- Measure the lengths of some your columns. Take the average and make (9) sashing strips that length from your background.
- Add a sashing strip to one side of each column, taking care to alternate the start of the column between layer cake fabric on top and background fabric on top, as per the diagram above.
- Sew the columns together
- Add a sashing strip to the side that is missing one
- Measure the width of your quilt at the top, bottom and middle. Take the average. Make (2) border strips of that size and sew them to the top and bottom of your quilt.
