

Triple Sliced Layer Cake

Finished size 49" x 59.5"



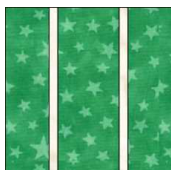
Fabric:

(20) 10" square pieces (half a layer cake)

1 yard sashing/dividing strips

1 yard border

1. Cut the layer cake pieces into 3", 4" and 3" strips; keep the strips from the same square together
2. Cut (17) 1" strips of the sashing fabric. Subcut to 10" pieces. (dividing strips within the blocks and between the blocks in a row)
3. Put a dividing strip between each of the 3 pieces of the same square, with the 3" strips on the outside and the 4" strip on the inside, as shown below. Sew the new pieces together. Your resulting square should measure 10" square.



4. Repeat for all 20 of the 10" squares.
5. Layout the blocks alternating vertical and horizontal sashing stripes in a 5x4 grid. Add sashing to the left side of each block, and on the last block in the row, add a sashing strip on the right also.
6. Sew the rows together
7. If you like corner stones between all the blocks, then follow these steps:
 - a. Cut (1) 1" strip of the sashing fabric. Subcut to 1" pieces. (corner stones)
 - Cut (6) 1" strips of the sashing fabric. Subcut to 10" strips (sashing strips)
 - Sew a 1" square to the left side of a 10" strip 4 times, then add a 1" square to the end of this piece. This is the sashing for 1 row. Make 6 of these strips
8. If you prefer to use long strips for your sashing, the follow these steps:
 - a. Cut (7) 1" strips of the sashing fabric.
 - b. Make 6 strips that are 43" long,
9. Sew the rows together with a sashing strip in between.
10. Add a sashing row to the top and bottom.
11. Cut the border fabric into (6) 3.5" wide strips.
12. Measure the top width and bottom width of your quilt; if the measurements aren't the same, use the average. Make 2 border strips that length and sew to the top and bottom of your quilt.
13. Measure the left side and the right side of your quilt, if the measurements aren't the same, use the average. Make 2 border strips of that length and sew to the sides of your quilt
