

- 45 Km Northwest of Kapuskasing, Ontario in McCowan, Neely, and Nixon Townships
- Claims span over 20Km along a NE trending magnetic high anomaly
- Multiple trenches and historic pits including the Miller Gold Occurrence
- Multiple generations of quartz stringers and veins up to 5 feet wide with associated arsenopyrite and gold mineralization in dark grey quartz
- Metasediments against the quartz veins are extremely silicified, sheared, and host arsenopyrite within fabric defined by biotite
- NE striking faults associated with the Kapuskasing structural Zone
- Historic assays of 1.8 g/t Au and 15.3 g/t Ag
- 2023 assays from grey quartz and silicified wall rocks have up to

1330 ppb Au
