

"Mass Intention" Request Form

- The suggested stipend for each Mass Intention is \$5.
- Generally speaking, we are not accepting requests for specific dates of celebration.
- Any person can only request up to five (5) Mass Intentions at a given time.
- Each individual Mass Intention must be filled out separately, even if more than one Mass is offered for the same person.
- Any person wishing to have a Mass Intention offered for more or less than the \$5 suggested donation (which they have a right to do), must schedule an appointment with Fr. Metrejean individually during office hours before their Mass Intention(s) will be accepted.
- Each individual Mass intention can only include <u>one</u> Name. The only exceptions are married couples (i.e. Mr./Mrs. John Doe)or an entire catholic family (i.e. the John Doe Family).
- Public Masses, generally speaking, can only be offered for living or deceased Catholics in good standing. To avoid scandal, the one requesting the Mass Intentions is responsible for ensuring that the one for whom the Mass is offered is currently a Catholic in good standing or died in that public state. Public Mass will not be offered for heretics, schismatics, nor public sinners.
- Once a Mass Intention is accepted, Fr. Metrejean has one year to fulfill that request. It is not guaranteed that one's Mass Intention request will be offered on the "preferred date of offering."
- A Mass Intention request is only considered "accepted" when Fr. Metrejean signs the acceptance line below.
