<p><b>EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:</b></p> <p>Performs preventive maintenance and repairs on fire hydrants, i.e. cleaning, painting, repair, replacement and /or lubrication of nozzles, caps, operating nuts, stems, gaskets, chains, etc.</p> <p>Inspection and testing of fire hydrant to ensure proper operation and to itemize deficiencies.</p> <p>Perform hydraulic testing on fire hydrants to establish flow capabilities, and to locate flow deficiencies.</p> <p>Collection of pertinent hydrant data through office and field investigation to become permanent records within the mainframe database, i.e. hydrant number, manufacturer, model, connections, year, valve opening size, accurate location, etc.</p> <p>Reports deficiencies found to the local water company to ensure repairs are made promptly.</p> <p>Job performance must conform to all Pace Fire Rescue District policies and procedures.</p> <p>Performs other duties as required.</p> <p><b>QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:</b></p> <p>Must be 18 years of age.</p> <p>Successful completion of a department provided physical examination and background check.</p> <p>Successful completion of department provided drug screening test.</p> <p>State of Florida Firefighter 1 certificate preferred but not required.</p> <p><b>Licensing Requirements (positions in this class typically require):</b></p> <p>Must have and maintain a valid Florida driver's license.</p>
