- Lt Adcox was the first on the scene and gave the board his report of the incident. From the time of dispatch to the time of arrival, it was 14 minutes. The main issue with this area is no water/hydrants.
- There were 25 apparatus's and 55 personnel on the scene; we had a Lieutenant and a Captain on sight. Our Operational Directive states to have a minimum of five per shift at all times. On Friday, August 13, a revised Operational Directive was sent out to all personnel stating as of September 1, and we will be increase ing it to six on shift at all times.
- Chief Whitfield has a meeting on September 1 with the developer, one home owner, and Mr. Boutwell from Pace Water System. The discussion will focus on finding ways to get more hydrants in that area, etc.
