10. New Ladder Truck Update

a. We have a completion date of the week of November 11th. We will go for the final inspection either the week of November 15th or December 1st. The new equipment has been ordered, hopefully it will get here before the truck. We are looking at delivery between Christmas and New Year. We will have everyone trained. The only concern is we might not receive the new equipment that has been ordered. If this happens we will transfer the current equipment temporarily so we can get it in service. We will have an official ceremony once it is in service. You will be notified well in advance of the ceremony date.

11. Station 4 Update

a. We are still looking at different ways to put manpower at Station 4. All the buildings we have looked at to either rent or buy have been junk. We are considering buying a 5th wheel. Commissioner Mills agreed this could be used as a duo-purpose because it could last 10 years. Chief Whitfield stated we would keep it in a building.

12. Retirement

- a. There is a new Resolution which modifies the existing plan that allows those who qualify buy back up to 5 years. Commissioner Mills asked what were the qualifications? Chief Whitfield explained you have to be here at least 3 years and five years fire service as well. Commissioner Mills asked if it was similar to what Midway offers? Chief Whitfield stated yes. It must be paid in full before you retire. It is competative with other departments. The modifications are good for the membership.
