They are now looking at moving the fire department to 2 acres facing Luther Fowler. If they decide not to move it, Chief Whitfield will work on them donating it or selling it to us so we can build another station on it.

9. Impact Fees


- a. During May the county went to an on-line permit system. Chief Whitfield spoke to Midway, Holley Navarre about impact fees dropping and they were having the same issue. Chief Whitfield called Avalon and theirs had dropped also. We all

knew that the interest rates had gone up, but it should've had that much of an effect of construction. After doing some research we found that the county system doesn't have anything on the application section about having to pay impact fees. People who are applying for permits proceed without paying the impact fee and getting a permit issued. We have recovered approximately \$16,000 and have found approximately \$8,000 that are unrecovered. Chief Whitfield has spoken to the county about putting a hold on the final CO until their impact fee is paid. We will be keeping an eye out for any further unrecovered fees.
